Committee Meeting Minutes

March 5, 2013

Committee Chairman Brian Paplham called the meeting to order at 8:00 a.m. Other committee members present for the meeting were, Bob Garfinkel, Ron Paider, and Chuck Wagner.

Also present for the meeting were, Andy Wallander - County Conservationist, Joe Johnson – District Conservationist, and Brian Maedke – Wildlife Damage Program.

Garfinkel moved to approve the meeting agenda and the minutes from the last meeting. Paider seconded the motion. All voted in favor of the motion.

Andy started the meeting by giving the committee an update on NR 151 Compliance letters that were sent out to six landowners since the Jan 8th meeting. The landowners are; David and Karen Frisque, Harris and Emily Dhuey, Glenn and Annette Teske, John Zeitler, Daniel DeVos and Shirley DeVos. All have come into compliance by filing nutrient management plans.

Brian attended the meeting to give an update and approval for continuing the Wildlife Damage Abatement and Claims Program for the county. Total claims in the County for 2012 were similar to last year. The total claims were \$5,134.34 and paid out was \$3,634.34. All funds are reimbursed by the state. Paider moved to approve the plan and payments. Garfinkel seconded the motion. All voted in favor of the motion.

There were three TRM (Targeted Runoff Management) grants applied for and approved for the County. They were; Kevin Fabry - \$111,600.00, Larry Dax - \$67,430.00 and Jeff Stangel - \$105,430.00.

Wagner moved to authorize Andy to sign all TRM grant applications. Paider seconded the motion. All voted in favor of the motion.

Andy then discussed with the committee sending a resolution to the full board for approval requesting state government to restore funding to County Land and Water Conservation Departments to the \$9.3 million level. The level of funding from the state has dropped severely in the last few years. Wagner moved to forward the resolution. Paider seconded the motion. All voted in favor of the motion.



Garfinkel moved to adjourn the meeting. Paider seconded the motion. All voted in favor. The meeting was adjourned at 9:46 a.m.
